One of the biggest advantages of the new site is there are less windows to open. Most of the information is accessible from just one or two windows, and there are some excellent new ways to compare runners in a race using the innovative tools. You can literally stack one runner's form

history on top of another, or even eliminate runners from the page to make assessment neater and quicker. The biggest change to take place in the Racing Post site's history is the fact that certain features which were previously FREE are now subscription based. We'll be covering all the membership options on pages 5 - 10

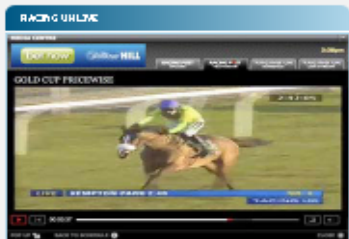

The core content (cards, news, results etc.) of the editions is consistent, but the panels displayed alongside the core content have been selected to meet the interests of the three types of user.

Consequently, the bloodstock edition makes great use of panels displaying such things as recent sales results, stallion tables and international ratings whereas the betting edition displays panels containing details of market movers and links to ante-post markets.

The racing edition attempts to tread the line between the other two.

To get a flavour of the differences you can flick between the home pages of the editions using the drop down selector in the grey menu bar.

The above screenshot shows Jockey Statistics for Aintree. I have highlighted R Walsh because he has the best wins to rides ratio in percentage terms. What's interesting is you'll notice although he has achieved a 21% strike rate over the last 5 seasons, backing all his runners would have returned a loss of -14.26 points.

This just confirms that his mounts are over-bet by the public. The bookies know when Ruby teams up with one of the top trainers at Aintree he's going to ride winners. As a result they reduce the odds to a point where there is little **value** to be had.

***Race Specialist Pro Tip:** Top jockeys win plenty of races but very often return a level stakes loss due to this factor. Conversely, looking down the list we can see that backing P Brennan's mounts over the last 5 seasons would have returned a level stakes profit of +25.07 even with a 5% lower strike rate. This indicates the average SP prices on his mounts represented better value than R Walsh's*

Exactly the same principle applies to Trainers as well. So if you're a backer it's pretty essential **to obtain value on your bets** otherwise, in the long run, your accounts will show a loss.

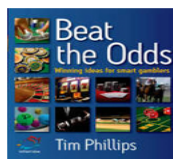

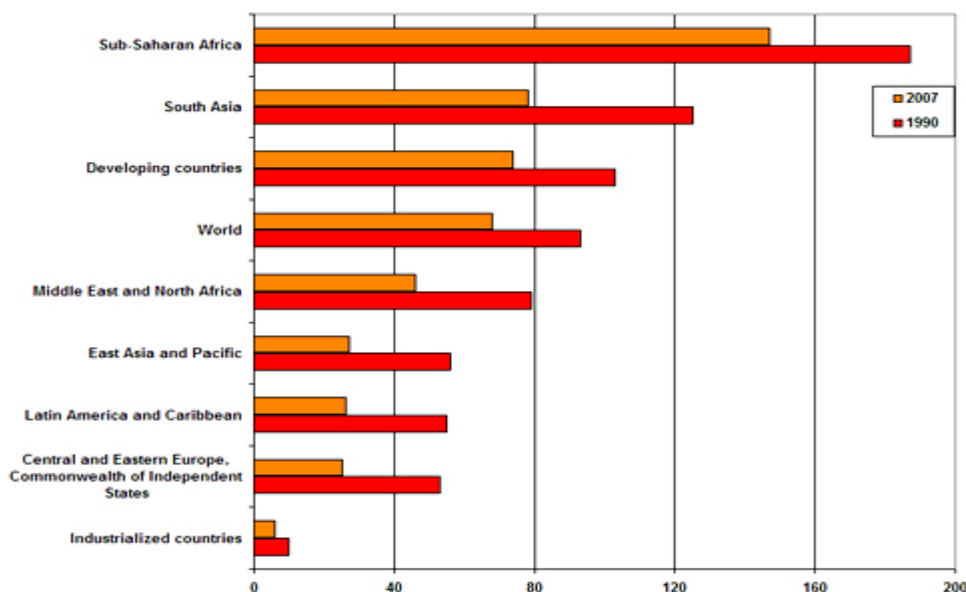

Here in the UK we take it for granted that everyone has access to basic life essentials, such as clean drinking water, food and education.

In 2007, 9.2 million children born alive worldwide died before their fifth birthday. Most of these children live in developing countries and die from a disease or a combination of diseases that could be easily prevented or treated -- antibiotics for pneumonia, for example, or a simple mix of salts and sugars for diarrhea. Malnutrition contributes to over a third of these deaths.

Child mortality is closely linked to poverty. Advances in infant and child survival have come more slowly in poor countries, and to the poorest people in wealthier countries. Improvements in public health services are key, including safe water and better sanitation. Education, especially for girls and mothers, will also save children's lives. Raising incomes can help, but little will be achieved unless a greater effort is made to ensure that services reach those who need them most.

Trends in under-five mortality The decline to 9.2 million in the number of children dying before the fifth birthday, follows a global decline in the under-five mortality rate since 1990. The global rate to be reached by 2015 is 31 per 1,000 live births and close to 60 per cent of countries have already reduced child mortality to this level. Most countries (130) are on track to achieve MDG 4.
